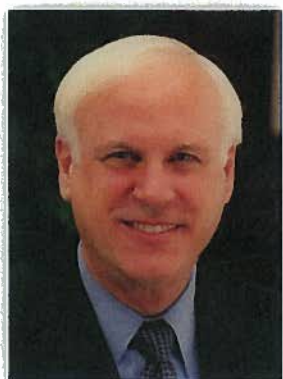

Steve Anderson joined the Whittier organization as a young business lawyer in 1981. At that time, the organization was led by the second generation of the Whittier family. Anderson was an up and coming associate at Parker, Milliken, Clark, O'Hara and Samuelian, the law firm which provided legal work to the Whittier family office. The family office sought in-house counsel to help them better address the needs which accompanied the influx of significant liquidity. Anderson was selected to serve as in-house counsel and has been part of the growth of the firm ever since.

Anderson helped guide the family office's decisions regarding selection of investment approach and advisors, management of other companies still held by the Whittiers, fiduciary and estate planning, charitable planning and strategic planning. He ultimately played a key role in converting the family office into a private trust company, with fiduciary and investment powers. The new trust company, which was chartered by the State of California in early 1989, would take on additional client families.

The Whittier Trust Companies have now grown to two separate companies, one based in California and one based in Nevada. The firm now advises on or manages over \$8 billion worth of assets. Anderson works to help maintain the family office service model that was in place when he arrived.

Through all of this growth, Anderson has developed a reputation for his high standards of integrity and ethics. He is keenly aware that his company's fiduciary obligation includes and in fact is predicated on making a promise today to provide service and security to someone's family after they are gone.
